### Open session

Shropshire Councillor Cllr.R.Tindall reported that Cllr.Steve Davenport (Shrops.Council Highways) was hoping that an increasing amount of remedial work would be carried out in the rural areas in the near future.

It now appeared that Shropshire Council's intention to rate Village Halls had been discounted.

Chairman The Chairman reported that he and the clerk had met Cllr. Michael Wood and asked for assistance with the Enforcement issues in the parish. Unfortunately Cllr Wood had been taken ill and was unable to report on the result of his enquiries.

Clerk The clerk had been involved in correspondence with other local clerks regarding Bridgnorth Town Council's proposals to investigate the possibility of a boundary review. BTC was short of building sites and was looking to adjacent parishes to provide the necessary ground.

Village hall The Chairman, Mrs.Blaze said that she and the clerk had spent some considerable time in examining the archives, many of which were out of date and had been removed for disposal .
